The Lake Champlain Maritime Museum presents a visual and interpreted timeline of eleven thousand years of human history, intersected in 1609 by the New World explorer Samuel de Champlain. The exhibit features a birch bark canoe similar to ones Champlain and his allies used and presents a reflection of the 19th century, when the lake was one of the most vibrant interstate commercial highways in the world. It also showcases the lake's most important shipwrecks and their stories.

Along with our research partners, we'll unveil the latest bathymetric map of Lake Champlain showing depth contours as they've never been seen before. Finally, with our partners from the Lake Champlain Basin Program and the EPA, we'll share "Sam's Tips" with visitors to enhance the future of this wonderful waterway.
