The Home Craft Department will open at 10 am each day for viewing and purchases. The department will close each night at 10 pm. On Monday, Sept. 6th, the last day of the Fair, we will close at 7 pm.

Rules

1. Entries should be made at the Home Crafts Department (*Blue Ribbon Pavilion*) on Tues, Aug 24th from 12 pm to 7 pm and Wed, Aug 25th from 8 am to 4 pm. No entries will be accepted after that day!
2. Please contact the superintendent for an assignment of number, all entry forms and rules.
3. All articles must be made by the exhibitor. Please place exhibitor number on all displays.
4. Soiled or broken items will not be accepted. Anything found in these conditions will be removed from display.
5. Exhibitors wishing to pre-tag their articles prior to entry day should contact the Superintendent prior to August 1st. All entries are to be listed on the Exhibitor's Entry Form. Tags must be typed or written legibly.
6. Each article is to be priced and sold separately. Items should be priced in \$0.50 increments only. Items will be sold for price marked on tag. No discounts for multiple purchases.
7. If an article is sold, the tag is removed, held, and returned to the exhibitor on settlement day.
8. Articles entered for judging may not have been previously entered and judged at this Fair.
9. Home Crafts staff members may assist in determining an article's judging class. The judges have the right to move an item to a different class or remove as necessary.
10. Each exhibitor may enter only one article for judging per class. Judges will determine 1st, 2nd and 3rd places and honorable mention per class. The judges decision will be final.
11. Machine made articles or articles (*knitted or crocheted*) with machine stitched ribbons or machine made button holes will not be judged. Also, please remove or cover-up name of exhibitor on items to be judged.
12. The Superintendent of Home Crafts reserves the right to reject any entry determined unworthy.
13. The Champlain Valley Exposition, Inc. will retain 22% of the selling price as commission for each and all articles sold.
14. The Champlain Valley Expo is not responsible for lost or damaged articles. We do make every effort to provide security and control.

15. Prize vouchers may be collected from the Superintendent starting Monday, August 30th at the Home Crafts Desk and redeemed at the Cashier's Office.
16. Any persons who are a business or act as a business shall enter their items for judging in the professional category in the division. Name and/or business name need to be covered or removed for judging.
17. Article Tags must be attached to items with safety pins or string. Safety pins are the responsibility of the crafter.
18. All Quilts must have size measurements on tag.
19. Garments need to have a sizing label and washing instructions.
20. Health & Beauty entries require a test sample and ingredients listed on product

Please Note Changes To Divisions And Classes

Youth Crafters

To encourage our youthful crafters, persons sixteen (16) years of age or younger will be given special consideration for their entries. Judges ask that age of crafter be listed on tag, please.

Best of Each Division

The judging staff will select one article from each class as the Best Of Division. A prize of \$5.00 will be paid to the exhibitor and a special ribbon will be awarded.

Youth - Best of Show

The judging staff will select one item as Youth Best of Show from all articles judged. A prize of \$10 and a special ribbon will be awarded.

Adult Best of Show - All Entries

The judging staff will select one item as the Best Of Show of all the articles entered and exhibited. A prize of \$25 will be paid to the exhibitor and a special ribbon will be awarded.

Article Return Day

In order that the "pick-up" or "article return day" is as smooth and efficient as possible for all of us, please review these rules and requests:

Pick up of unsold articles and payment for sold items is Thurs, Sept 9th from 10 am to 6 pm. **No articles may be picked up before this date.**

If you have any problems with this date, please contact the superintendent. Articles not picked up on Thursday, Sept. 9th will be held by the superintendent until Oct. 1, after which they will become the property of the Champlain Valley Exposition, Inc.

Please bring your Exhibitor's Receipt when picking up articles.

Please understand that each exhibitor's entries, sales, prizes, and returns are reconciled with a home craft worker and that this process takes time.

When the reconciliation is mutually agreed to, the exhibitor and the home craft worker will initial the settlement form which will include the amount of monies due.

A representative of the cashier's office will be in the Home Craft Department and will then pay in cash the net monies due.
