To avoid Rt 15 traffic, we would like to encourage exhibitors to use Gate F off of VT RT2A (north). From the 5-way intersection take VT Route 2A north (also known as Lincoln Street) for 1/2 mile, turn Left (you will pass Saint James Episcopal Church) travel to the end and Gate F is in front of you. You can reach the 5-way intersection from I-89 (The Williston exit).

Below are other directions, but you will most likely incur heavy traffic later in the day.

To go this way, from Interstate 89, take Route 15 east to Essex Junction. Fairgrounds on the left side opposite Dunkin Donuts. Fairgrounds is located on Rt 15 (105 Pearl Street) Essex Junction VT 05453

Special note

There will be a "major" concert at the fair Saturday evening (*Jeff Dunham - one of the hottest comedy acts in America*) and another on Sunday evening (*Kid Rock*) scheduled. This will impact traffic and parking in late afternoon. There may also be fireworks at dusk.

Show Rules & General Information

Exhibitors are responsible for knowing the rules pertaining to the classes they enter. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current VHSA, VSA, USEF Rule Books and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. By signing the entry form you agree to abide by all the rules of this show.

Classes are open to any breed of horse/pony (grade or registered) unless specified in the rule book.

Classes are open to everyone meeting the criteria of the class!

You do not have to be a member to participate!

Rule books are available at the entry stand to review, or join Vermont Horse Shows Association to get one of your own for free! Please visit: www.vhsa.org (rule book is online!) and www.ilovehorseshow.com

The show steward, show manager, or the secretary will be happy to answer any questions.

Awards

Six Ribbons in all classes. Special Awards & Cash Prize(s) in several classes. For those winning prize money the recipients will be paid with vouchers, show management will explain how to cash them in.

Fees

Numbers will not be issued until all entry blanks are signed and a signed blank check left or fees paid.

Pre-Entry: Pre-entries must be postmarked on or before **August 29**. Pre-entry fees listed on class list.

Post Entry Fee: \$3 additional per class if postmarked after **August 29** or adding/entered the day of the show.

"Discounts for Youth Pre-Entry"- any exhibitor under the age of 18 years may show for 1/2 the regular class fee & 1/2 stall fee if they pre-enter; any classes added after pre-entry are regular fees plus post entry fee. **New for 2009** - If you are an exhibitor in the 4-H show on Saturday, you must post your full name on stall door on Saturday by 1pm if participating in the "discount for youth pre-entry" Failure to post your name clearly will void the discount and you will have to pay the full pre-entry amount or forfeit entry fees.

Other: The horse show area does not charge admission. Admission tickets for the fair will be available to exhibitors from horse show manager on show day.

Copy fees: To avoid \$2/copy, please provide copies with entry of coggins, rabies, 4-H card, and registration papers if showing in breed classes, as applicable.

Non-Negotiable Checks: Exhibitor will be charged \$75 plus collection fees and exhibitor fees. Person(s) with non-negotiable checks from other horse shows will not be allowed to exhibit until they have settled their indebtedness with the other show(s). Unfortunately we will post your bad check for all to see, and legal action will be take. In addition, refer to VHSA Rule 1.M Indebtedness to a VHSA affiliated show. All entries not paid in full at the show will be charged a \$25 billing fee.

Health Requirements

Please provide a photocopy for our records: Negative Coggins test & proof of Rabies vaccination within 12 months of the event will be checked at the entry stand. Out of state exhibitors are expected to have a certificate of veterinary inspection within 30 days and it may be checked by the Vermont state veterinarian.

Campers

Reserve early! Go to www.cvexpo.org to download the camper request form.! Any questions call the camper manager Mike at 802-872-0686 or the fairgrounds office early at 802-878-5545 for information or availability. Please do not park in front of other campers. The Camper Manager will require you to move and you will not be allowed to show until you comply!!!! Please be aware of the "check out" time for campers, listed in the camper contract. Be advised - Camper space sells out early!

Stabling

Prepayment is a requirement for stall reservations- \$30/stall. Initial lose first bedding is available on a first come, first serve basis, and is not guaranteed. All stalls include half doors; some have full doors. Horses may not remain in trailers overnight. Trailers transporting stabled horses will have to park in the "far" lot, not by the barns. Arrival Time: After 5 p.m. on 9-5-09, please, due to preceeding 4-H show; or anytime on 9-6-09. Removal Time: Exhibits must be removed within 4 hours of the conclusion of the show, unless granted permission from show manager.

Refunds

No class entry fee shall be returned because of withdrawal of a contestant except where an entry, through illness or injury, is unable to exhibit. In such case, all unused class entry fees shall be returned upon the receipt of a physician's/veterinarian's note if received by show management no later than 6pm on the day of the show. Any error made in entering a class is assumed by the exhibitor and is not the responsibility of management. No refund on stall or office fees.

Measuring/Schooling

Location & time for measuring and location of schooling area will be posted at the entry stand.

Delay Of Classes

The in-gate will be closed two (2) minutes after the first animal enters the ring, except if management grants a tack change or hold on the class. Management reserves the right to limit said time. In the event the PA system fails, exhibitors will still be expected to appear on time. No refunds for failing to enter the ring on time.

Management Reserves The Right To

1) add to or vary the list of invited officials; 2) decline or refuse any entry at this show without being held liable; 3) eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or equine should the best interest of the show be served; 4) not delay classes due to conflicts, and not to allow substitutions of animals or classes; 5) change the order of classes before or during the show and combine or cancel classes. Should any questions or disputes arise not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to the show steward whose decision shall be final.

The construction and application of VHSA and VSA rules are governed by the State of Vermont, and any action instituted against the VHSA and VSA must be filed in Vermont State. **Under Vermont Law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities that are obvious and necessary, pursuant to 12 V.S.A. 1039.**
