- 1) you have 30 seconds to attract some one's attention
- 2) you have another 30 seconds to keep their attention
- 3) your exhibit should explain why someone would want to do that activity with the Grange and not some other community service organization

Exhibits will be taken down on Monday, September 6 after 7:00 pm.
